The occasion was graced by Dr. Aarti Gupta, Chief Investment Officer, Anikarth Ventures, Dr. Nimish Kapoor, Department of Science & Technology, (Ministry of Science and Technology), and Mr. Vikas Prakash, Startup Incubation and Innovation Centre (SIIC), IIT Kanpur as the speaker of the day with other members of the governing council Mrs. Ritu Gupta, Vice-Chairperson, Jagran Education Foundation, Dr. J.N.Gupta, CEO, Jagran Education Foundation, Dr. Divya Chowdhry, Director Jagran Institute of Management and all the distinguished members including directors, principals, faculty, staff, students of other departments.

The inaugural session of the one-day symposium was jointly started by Dr. Aarti Gupta, Chief Investment Officer, Anikarth Ventures and Dr. Divya Chowdhry, Director, Jagran Institute of Management. Various issues like entrepreneurship, family business and startups were the topics of discussion in the symposium. Dr. Aarti Gupta said that in today's era to establish any new business and startup plans, it is very important to have knowledgeable work, management and continuity towards it. Only then will we be successful in taking any enterprise forward smoothly for a long time. While addressing the students, she said that more than 75 startup are being developed today, which will take India to a new heights as a strong economy for the next 50 years. She said that there are more than 900 million internet users in India, which 56% are from rural areas and 65% are women. The imagination of human life is incomplete without inventions. No business can survive without continuity, but continuity is essential for greater entrepreneurship.

While speaking in the technical session, Dr. Nimish Kapoor said that the youth can also establish employment-oriented enterprises through more and more new inventions. Global Entrepreneurship Programs help in harnessing the best of entrepreneurship in the global market. To become a successful entrepreneur, you have to focus on many sectors like new venture creation, social entrepreneurship, family business and corporate entrepreneurship, funding etc.

In the second technical session (In Post-lunch session), Mr. Vikas Prakash said that many better options are currently available to us in setting up a trial scheme for new startups. First time, in the year 2001, IIT Kanpur, in collaboration with small and medium units, established Incubation Cell by the Government of India to provide new ideas to students in the field of entrepreneurship on the lines of developing countries, where students can decide which direction is best for building future.

In the third technical session, student's teams from MCA, MBA and other technical & management institutes participated and gave presentations related to their respective subject/topic. The student's teams' performance was evaluated on the basis of concept clarity and their delivery of presentation. The competition was judged by Dr. Anil Kumar Singh, Mr. Ashish Mishra, Mr. Vishnu Kumar Shukla, Mr. Anand Kumar Dixit and Mr. Adarsh Srivastav.

In total, there will be 21 presentations. Technical Session I will feature 7 presentations, while Technical Session II & III will have 14 presentations. The presenters hail from various institutions across the country, including GNA University, Shivaji College of Delhi University, Sunbeam College Varanasi, JECRC University Jaipur, Banaras Hindu University, Axis Institute of Planning and Management, Rainbow Public School Garhwal, and Jagran Institute of Management.

On this occasion, Principal of Jagran Degree College, Director of Jagran Institute of Management and Mass Communication, Director of Jagran Institute of Digital Animation and all the faculty members of concern departments, staff and students were present.

At the end, certificates awards were given to the keynote speakers and the participating student teams were selected by the faculty jury of the institute.
